## 1 DETAILS OF PARTIES

1.1 The names and addresses of the parties to the reference (TTC301) are as follows:-

- (a) Northern Rail Limited whose Registered Office is at Serco House, 16 Bartley Wood Business Park, Bartley Way, Hook, Hampshire RG27 9UY ("Northern") ("the Claimant"); and
- (b) Network Rail Infrastructure Limited whose Registered Office is at Kings Place, 90 York Way, London N1 9AG ("Network Rail") ("the Respondent").

## 2 THE PARTIES' RIGHT TO BRING THIS REFERENCE

- 2.1 This matter is referred to a Timetabling Panel ("the Panel") for determination in accordance with Conditions D 2.1.7 and D5 of the Network Code<sup>1</sup> which is incorporated into the Track Access Contract between the parties dated 4 February 2005.
- 2.2 The dispute relates to the consultation of the Rules of the Route ("RoR") for the Subsidiary Timetable 2010. Conditions D 2.1.5, D 2.1.7 and D 5.1.1 are relevant and include the following extracts:

### *"2.1.5 Rules of the Route/Plan Decision*

- (a) Network Rail shall, following consideration of any representations, objections and alternative proposals made by affected Bidders...., review the Preliminary Rules of the Route Proposal.....and, having due regard to the Decision Criteria, decide what amendments if any should be made to the applicable Rules of the Route....."
- (b) Network Rail shall....notify each Bidder which is likely to be affected by the applicable Rules of the Route.....of the amendments it has decided to make pursuant to Condition D2.1.5(a) ....."

### *"2.1.7 Referral to the relevant ADRR Panel*

Following notification of Network Rail's decisions in accordance with Condition D2.1.5(b)....a Bidder may refer any aspect of those decisions....for determination by the relevant ADRR Panel under Condition D5..."

### *"5.1.1 Grounds for making an appeal*

..... If any Bidder is dissatisfied with any decision of Network Rail made under this Part D, including:

- (a) the application by Network Rail of the Decision Criteria;  
.....it may refer the matter to the relevant ADRR Panel for determination."

### **3 CONTENTS OF REFERENCE**

The Parties have together produced this joint reference and it includes:-

- (a) The subject matter of the dispute in Section 4;
- (b) A summary of the issues in dispute in Section 5;
- (c) A detailed explanation of the issues in dispute prepared by the claimant with a paragraph by paragraph response from the respondent(s) in Section 6;
- (d) Any further issues raised by the respondent in Section 7;
- (e) The decisions of principle sought from the Panel in respect of legal entitlement and remedies in Section 8; and
- (f) Appendices and other supporting material.

### **4 SUBJECT MATTER OF DISPUTE**

- 4.1 This is a dispute that relates to the consultation of RoR for the 2010 Subsidiary Timetable, and changes made by the Respondent to Version 3 and published in Version 4.
- 4.2 The process to be used for the consultation of RoR is outlined in Parts D 2.1 and D 6 of the Network Code (Part D version dated 1 September 2008 contained within the current Network Code), and details of the actual process to be followed is contained in National Rules of the Plan Section 1.3.
- 4.3 A copy of Section 1.3 and an extract from Section 1.8 of the National Rules of the Plan (NRoP) is attached at Annex A.
- 4.4 There is some confusion between NRoP and the RoR arising from the version numbers that are associated with the Principal and Subsidiary Timetables (or both). The following convention is adopted throughout this submission:

Version 1	Preliminary RoR Proposal for the Principal and Subsidiary Change Dates 2010
Version 2	Final/Decision Document for the Principal Change Date 2010
Version 3	Preliminary RoR Proposal for the Subsidiary Change Date 2010
Version 4	Final/Decision Document for the Subsidiary Change Date 2010

- 4.5 A copy of the relevant extract from the notes of an EEA meeting held on 12 March 2009 is attached at Annex B
- 4.6 A copy of the relevant extracts of RoR Versions 1, 3 and 4 are attached at Annex C.
- 4.7 A copy of the relevant extract from the LNW Route Remit v0.2 October 2009 is attached at Annex D.

## SUMMARY OF DISPUTE

- 5.1.1 When RoR Version 1 (see Annex C) was issued on 14 November 2008, it contained a proposal to block the WCML between Euxton Junction and Winwick Junction on eight Sundays in Period E2 (weeks 30 – 37, 23/10-11/12). No formal response is required to the Subsidiary Timetable elements of V1, but the Claimant did comment (see Annex C) that the proposed times of 22:50 Saturday – 00:20 Monday were acceptable. When Version 3 (see Annex C) was issued on 24 April 2009, the Claimant noted that the proposed possession had been extended southwards to Weaver Junction (which did not affect the Claimants services) and the start time brought forward to 21:00 Saturday, and decided that as the proposed possessions were consistent with possessions that it had accepted in previous years, and that disruption to customer journeys on the affected route would be minimized by accepting the possessions, the Claimant notified the Respondent in accordance with Condition D 2.1.4(b) that it would be prepared to accept the proposed possessions, subject to the start time being revised to the original 22:50 Saturday start time notified in Version 1.
- 5.1.2 When RoR Version 4 (see Annex C) was received by the Complainant on 31 July 2009, it became apparent that the blockages had been amended, but that the start time had not been changed back from 21:00 to 22:50 on Saturday as requested in the Claimant's response to Version 3; but had in fact been brought forward to start at 13:35 on Saturdays and the finish time had also been brought forward from 00:05 Mondays to 15:00 Sundays. When challenged, the Respondent explained that this change had been made to allow West Coast Trains to operate its full Sunday afternoon service pattern on the WCML. The Complainant was not consulted in advance of the issue of Version 4 in respect of its response to Version 3, or the proposed disruption to its services on Saturday afternoons, now shown for the first time in Version 4, and believes that because the Respondent did not seek the views of the Complainant on the proposed disruption to its services on Saturday afternoons, before making the decision, that it was not sufficiently informed to apply the Decision Criteria when the decision was made to issue the changes in Version 4. No evidence was supplied to the Complainant at the time, or subsequently, that the Decision Criteria were applied to this decision.
- 5.1.3 The Complainant notified a dispute concerning several issues in Version 4 to the Disputes Secretary on 21 August 2009. All the other issues have subsequently been resolved, but the decision that is the subject of this submission remains unresolved.
- 5.1.4 Discussions continued with the Respondent to see if the proposed renewals could be re-packaged to avoid disruption to Northern services on Saturdays. In the course of these discussions, the Respondent advised the Claimant that the decision to re-time the possessions had been taken "at a Senior Level" within Network Rail, and the Complainant became aware of the LNW Route Remit (see Annex D).
- 5.1.5 The Complainant is aware of the development of Efficient Engineering Access (EEA) and the notes of a meeting (see Annex B), when the Respondent shared the emerging EEA principles to be applied to this route section showing a Sunday possession requirement of "**7x 27hrs traditionally in Period E**" qualified by "**Between Weaver Jn and Warrington South and Winwick Jn and Wigan North Jn, suggested possession times to be 1200 Sat to 1500 Sun. Geographical locations outside these points to be negotiated**", and that "**VT do not**

*support the 27hr possessions and ask the route section Weaver Jn to Euxton to be constrained by EEA rules".*

- 5.1.6 The Complainant subsequently became aware of the LNW Route Remit (see Annex D). The purpose of the LNW Route Remit is: "*to provide an overview of the Network Availability project for London North Western in line with the ORR regulated outputs measures*"
- 5.1.6.1 Figure 2 of the document states the current access strategy for the WCML is: "*In terms of weekend possessions, access principles vary according to the section concerned. Wherever possible, Network Rail try to "time" possessions to start around lunchtime on Saturdays and finish around lunchtime on Sundays (and extending to Monday lunchtimes over Bank Holiday weekends). This is at the request of Virgin Trains who wish to market their weekend services on "key services" on a Saturday morning and Sunday afternoons between London and Scotland during such disruption*"
- 5.1.6.2 Figure 2 also states: "*EEA means that we (Network Rail) are only allowed to cause one VT (Virgin Trains) service group to be diesel-hauled (vice the normal electric traction) at any one time*"
- 5.1.6.3 It also states: "*Weaver – Euxton Jn is planned on EEA Rules where possible but the access requirements on this section are informed by the volume of condition-led PL and S&C renewals which are needed through CP4. Access on this section will generally be in the region of 12x26hr weekend possessions per annum with 49 hrs taken on Bank Holidays for complex S&C renewals. Note that there are 112 S&C units which need to be renewed between Weaver Jn – Preston through CP4 and into CP5.* This situation exists despite the extensive possessions taken in recent years during the implementation of the West Coast Route Modernisation.
- 5.1.6.4 During Period E2, long - established diversionary routes are available for West Coast services via the Manchester area on Sundays, but these routes are not electrified and diesel haulage would be required. The Claimant believes that on Sundays in Period E2, there is no requirement for any West Coast Train's service group to be diesel hauled.
- 5.1.6.6 At no point has the Respondent entered into any discussions or negotiations with the Claimant prior to the decision to disrupt Northern's Saturday services on this route, as is required by NRP 1.8.5 (see Annex A) which states: "*Where conflicts arise between the aspirations of different Train Operators or with Rules of the Route/Plan, Network Rail will resolve those conflicts by agreement between the parties wherever possible, otherwise by according priority in accordance with the priority levels set out in Part D of the Network Code and by application of Decision Criteria*".
- 5.1.7 The Claimant's services affected by the proposed blockages on Saturdays are specified in the Claimant's SLC by Merseytravel, and are used on Saturdays by significant numbers of passengers travelling to/from Liverpool City Centre, for shopping, leisure and Premier League Football. In summary there is 1tph Blackpool – Liverpool and 2tph Liverpool - Wigan in both directions; with all services operating via St Helens. The proposed blockage will mean that these trains are only able to operate between Liverpool and St Helens. It effectively means that

all customers who travel over the section of route between St Helens and Preston will start their journey by train and face a longer return journey by road. The reverse applies on Sundays, when there is only 1tph Blackpool - Liverpool in both directions, and customers travelling on Sundays have regular experience of bus replacement, and a much smaller number are affected. Northern would prefer disruption on Sunday afternoons to the proposed disruption on Saturday afternoons.

- 5.1.8 The Complainant holds Firm Contractual Rights (FCRs) to operate Services between Blackpool, Wigan and Liverpool via St Helens on Saturdays and Sundays. These FCRs were held at the Priority Date in January 2009 applicable to the 2010 Subsidiary Timetable. On the Priority Date, Version 1 of the RoR showed the possessions between Winwick Junction and Euxton Junction to be taken on Sundays. The Claimant made its declaration on the basis that Sunday services on the affected route would be disrupted as shown in Version 1, but that Saturday services would be unaffected.
- 5.2 There is no suggestion that the timescales for the issue and response to RoR Versions 3 and 4 have not been followed by either party.

## 6 EXPLANATION OF EACH ISSUE IN DISPUTE WITH RESPONSE

- 6.1.1 The Claimant believes that the Respondent made the decision to amend RoR Version 3 and retime the possessions outside the Part D process, and outside the process shown in section 1.8.5 of the NRoP (see Annex A) which requires the Respondent to apply the Decision Criteria. Northern believes that the Respondent did not apply the Decision Criteria because there were no discussions held with Northern before the issue of Version 4 to establish the relative impact of the possessions on Northern and Northern's customers on Saturday afternoons. Northern believes that the Respondent failed in the execution of one of the procedures to which it is contracted through the Track Access Contract and the Network Code and merely applied the non-contractual EEA policy outlined in the LNW Route Remit.
- 6.1.2 Response to Issue 1 by Respondent.
- 6.2.1 Northern believes that the over-arching policy adopted by Network Rail to take 27hr possessions on the WCML between mid-day Saturday and Mid-day Sunday, without individual reference to the Decision Criteria, constitutes a bi-lateral agreement that unreasonably puts one operator at a disadvantage, in order to advantage others and is outside the Part D process.
- 6.2.2 Response to Issue 2 by Respondent.
- 6.3.1 The Claimant believes that the Respondent was not entitled to deny the Claimant the ability to exercise its FCRs on Saturday afternoons by varying the RoR after the Priority Date in a manner that has previously been determined (ttc129) that "***in the event of such an appeal, the existence of asserted rights that would be frustrated by the changes to Rules of the Route/Rules of the Plan may be a compelling reason to direct Railtrack either to withdraw the proposal, or to modify it sufficiently that the rights in question can be honoured;***"
- 6.3.2 The Claimant believes that the Respondent did not follow the process outlined in National Rules of the Plan to resolve the apparent conflict between the Claimant and West Coast Trains prior to making the decision that was notified in Version 4 of Rules of the Route.
- 6.3.3 Response to Issue 3 by Respondent

## **7 ANY FURTHER ISSUES RAISED**

- 7.1 The Subsidiary Timetable 2010 was offered to the Claimant on 18 December 2009 and reflects the timetable impact of the disputed blockages as shown in Version 4.
- 7.2 Response by Respondent.

## **8 DECISION SOUGHT FROM THE PANEL**

- 8.1 The Panel is asked to determine:
- (a) Was the Respondent entitled to make a decision to amend the Rules of the Route without applying the Decision Criteria.
  - (b) Was the Respondent entitled to adopt an over-arching policy which makes a significant change to the days and times when disruptive possessions will be taken to unreasonably put one Train Operator at a disadvantage in order to advantage another.
  - (c) Is the previously determined ttc129 which considered changes to Rules of the Route made after the Priority Date and during the timetable development process relevant to the determination of this dispute.
- 8.2 The Panel is asked to make the following specific remedies.
- (a) To instruct the Respondent to withdraw the changes made to RoR Version 3 and issued in Version 4 which will potentially disrupt Northern's services on Saturday afternoons and to revert to the possession start time shown in Version 1
  - (b) To instruct the Respondent to revise the timetable offer made to Northern on 18 December 2009 by including all Saturday services between Liverpool, Wigan, Preston and Blackpool for which Northern held FCRs at the Priority Date, and by withdrawing the Sunday services..
- 8.3 The Panel is asked to decide the following other issue:
- (a) Should the Respondent be required to obtain the views of potentially affected bidders so as to be fully informed prior to making a decision in accordance with Condition D2.1.5(a) by the application of the Decision Criteria.

## **9 APPENDICES AND ANNEXES**



### 1.3. Rules of the Route/Plan

- 1.3.1. Network Rail presented its ideas for the future development of Rules of the Route at a meeting with Bidders on 9<sup>th</sup> September. Such was the nature of the feedback from that meeting that Network Rail has brought forward its proposals to apply from the 2010 timetable development period.
- 1.3.2. In summary, the intention is to reduce the number of versions of Rules of the Route from 3 per timetable to 2 per timetable. To reflect this, an increased period of time has been incorporated into the response periods. Line of Route meetings will be held, involving Bidders and Network Rail planners, to review Bidders responses and help inform the content of our Decision Documents. Recognising that using the formal disputes process remains important to our Bidders, extra time has been allowed for this in the programme.
- 1.3.3. Network Rail will hold discussions with Train Operators to establish their aspirations and any areas of concern. These factors will be taken into account in preparing a Preliminary Proposal.
- 1.3.4. Network Rail will issue their Preliminary Proposals to Train Operators at TT-56 weeks, flagging items which have changed since the previous agreed version of Rules of the Route/Plan.
- 1.3.5. Train Operators have 5 weeks to consider the Preliminary Proposal and make a formal response accepting or proposing alternatives. No response is deemed as acceptance.
- 1.3.6. Network Rail will consider responses from Train Operators over the following 10 weeks and determine whether any proposed alternatives should be accepted. Where a proposed alternative is not accepted, Network Rail will firstly seek; through Line of Route meetings to see what changes can be accommodated. At the end of this period, Network Rail will advise Bidders of their Decisions along with their reasons for the non-acceptance of counter-proposals. (Version 2)
- 1.3.7. Network Rail will issue a formal notification of its decision(s) to accept, reject or amend its preliminary proposals to Rules of the Plan (Version 2) and Rules of the Route, in the form of Network Rail Decision (Version 2), flagging items which have changed since the Preliminary Proposal.
- 1.3.8. Train Operators will consider the Network Rail Decision for Rules of the Route and Rules of the plan issued at TT-41 and need to make a further formal response either accepting or rejecting our decisions. No response is deemed as acceptance. Train Operators, who reject our decisions, must then follow 1.3.9.
- 1.3.9. Train Operators may appeal against the content of the notification of changes. Any appeals must be notified to the Access Disputes Secretary within 5 Working Days of receipt of the notification of decisions from Network Rail.
- 1.3.10. Network Rail, which has a published plan of work in this respect, and Train Operators, will continue to jointly review Rules of the Plan throughout the timetable drafting period. Network Rail will make amendments, following the process set out in section 3 of this document, to optimise ROTP and the resultant Draft and First Working Timetables (as appropriate), having due regard to the Decision Criteria.
- 1.3.11. Network Rail also has an active Performance Improvement Programme to identify and resolve infelicities contained in Rules of the Plan. Where further changes are necessary these will be through the issue of amendments, to the relevant route ROTP.
- 1.3.12. National Rules of the Plan covering timetable planning processes will be prepared by Network Rail HQ. All other parts of Rules of the Plan will be prepared by the relevant Network Rail Train Planning Centre using a unified national format. Rules of the Route will be prepared by Network Rail's Network Access Unit.
- 1.3.13. Rules of the Route/Plan covering the Principal and Subsidiary timetable periods will be issued as part of the Principal timetable development process. Network Rail may propose revisions to Rules of the Route/Plan as part of the development processes for the Subsidiary timetable period provided that those revisions are of a minor nature or which could not reasonably have been foreseen when the Principal Rules of the Route/Plan were prepared.
- 1.3.14. Either Train Operators or Network Rail can propose that Performance Allowances may be limited to certain days and periods within that day; for example SX morning peak. Where such proposals are implemented they will apply to all train operators passing through the location(s) specified whether or not they have an identifiable peak service group.

## **1.8.Preparation of the Draft Timetable**

1.8.5. Where conflicts arise between the aspirations of different Train Operators or with Rules of the Route/Plan, Network Rail will resolve those conflicts by agreement between the parties wherever possible, otherwise by according priority in accordance with the priority levels set out in Part D of the Network Code and by application of Decision Criteria.

1.8.6. Notwithstanding the provisions set out above, all Network Rail's decisions during the timetable drafting process must be informed by consideration of the overall public interest as expressed in the Decision Criteria. For example, it may be appropriate for Network Rail, after consultation with affected Train Operators, to adjust paths to achieve pattern services, even spread of services, improved connections, efficient use of capacity, reservation of capacity for spot bids, and to optimise the balance between Rules of the Route/Plan and train slots.

### Section 4

#### **Period E2**

NW1001 Winwick Junction – Euxton Junction

We are not prepared to accept the altered timings of this Period Block, which significantly increases the impact on Northern services. The proposed timings effectively result in double the duration of disruption to our Liverpool – Wigan – Blackpool services, as we would be running trains on Saturday mornings, but customers would then need to return by bus. Our resource base would be significantly disrupted, with units and crews out of position, due to the shutdown on Saturday lunchtime and the start up on Sunday afternoon. The number of trains directly affected is significantly increased, from about 30 for the originally proposed all day Sunday block to over 60 for the revised proposal, which seems disproportionate, but further trains may also be affected when the railway is open due to resource displacement. In addition, we would not be prepared to agree to the loss of our Manchester – Airport shuttle, or any other alterations in the Manchester area which may be proposed on Saturday afternoons to accommodate diverted Virgin services. Whilst we appreciate that the possession timings included in Version 3 created issues for other operators, these were acceptable to Northern, and we are looking to see a return to these times.

### Section 7

Weeks 31 – 37.

NW1001 Weaver Jn – Euxton Jn 1335 Sat – 1500 Sun.

As per the Period E2 Period Block, we are not prepared to accept the altered timings of these items, which significantly increase the impact on Northern services. The proposed timings effectively result in double the duration of disruption to our Liverpool – Wigan – Blackpool services, as we would be running trains on Saturday mornings, but customers would then need to return by bus. Our resource base would be significantly disrupted, with units and crews out of position, due to the shutdown on Saturday lunchtime and the start up on Sunday afternoon. The number of trains directly affected is significantly increased, from about 30 for the originally proposed all day Sunday block to over 60 for the revised proposal (75 in Weeks 32 and 33, when the possession extends from Weaver Junction), which seems disproportionate, but further trains may also be affected when the railway is open due to resource displacement. In addition, we would not be prepared to agree to the loss of our Manchester – Airport shuttle, or any other alterations in the Manchester area which may be proposed on Saturday afternoons to accommodate diverted Virgin services.

## 1. Introduction

### 1.1 Purpose of Document

The purpose of this document is to provide an overview of the Network Availability project for London North Western in line with the ORR regulated outputs measures.

This document covers the outline scope of all aspects of the project as they have developed to date on London North Western Route. Some of the details provided are high level at this stage of the definition process. Further definition work is still to be completed and will be covered through GRIP feasibility studies where required.

Figure 1 below highlights the Strategic Business Plan (SBP) routes on LNW. For each of these SBP routes, a Route Plan has already been produced detailing the current capability and use for each strategic route, a description of the vision for the route's future, and the strategy for achieving that vision. The Route Plan strategies themselves build upon the Route Utilisation Strategies.
